ENGINEERING & CONSTRUCTION MANAGER

Summary

The South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA), a tri-county public transit authority serving Miami-Dade, Broward and Palm Beach counties, is seeking an Engineering & Construction Manager to Provide assistance in the management of all work in planning, organizing, and directing the Engineering & Construction, Maintenance of Way, Rolling Stock Procurement, Positive Train Control, and Environmental functions, including maintenance of the Dispatch System for the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA). Assist the Director of the Engineering and Construction Department in ensuring the effective and efficient use of staff and consultants to accomplish organizational goals.

Responsibilities

- Assist in the development and maintenance of a comprehensive long term capital program for all assets, including tracks, signals, grade crossings, stations, facilities, and utilities in coordination with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the South Florida Rail Corridor (SFRC).
- Manage department staff, including: approving and monitoring work schedules; identify training opportunities; evaluating performance; developing staff to meet organizational needs; managing and balancing work-loads; and assigning tasks, duties and projects.
- Supervise project management staff, architects, engineers, consultants, contractors, and other personnel under contract, to develop and implement projects relating to design and construction.
- Direct the functions and activities of the Engineering and Construction Department in the absence of the Director of Engineering and Construction.
- Provide support in consultant/contractor evaluations, perform fee negotiations, prepare and/or oversee the development of technical specifications and estimates. Review and approve consultant services.
- Assist in the development of an improvement oversight plan for Maintenance of Way and environmental compliance for SFRC.

Required Qualifications

- Knowledge of the principles, practices, procedures, and information sources of the engineering profession.
- Knowledge of applicable Federal, State and local laws, regulations and codes governing the design, permitting and construction of transportation infrastructure.
- Knowledge of management principles and practices, including techniques conducive to motivating subordinates and building morale.

Required Education/Experience

- Bachelor of Science from an accredited college or university with a major in engineering, construction management, or related field.
- Six (6) years of progressively responsible experience in engineering & construction with an emphasis in the Construction/Transportation/Railroad industry to include three (3) years of staff supervisory, budgetary and management responsibilities.
- Active Professional License in good standing.

Preferred Education/Experience

- Master's Degree from an accredited college or university with a concentration in Engineering, Construction Management, or closely related field.
- Active State of Florida Professional Engineer (PE) License in good standing.
- At least seven (7) years of progressively responsible professional experience in related public/private Construction/Transportation/Railroad engineering work.
- At least five (5) years of staff supervisory, budgetary and management responsibilities.
- Possession of a valid driver's license or ability to obtain a valid Florida driver's license within three (3) months of hire.
