"IF YOU SEE SOMETHING SUSPICIOUS, SAY SOMETHING"

That's the message that the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority and our regional transit partners are trying to impart to passengers. On Wednesday, November 4, 2009, as part of the Transit Watch Program, Operation Transit Shield II went into effect. This event is a regional effort by the SFRTA, along with Amtrak, Broward County Transit, Miami-Dade Transit, Palm Tran and CSX Transportation, as well as federal and local law-enforcement and first-responder agencies.

The idea behind Operation Transit Shield II is to demonstrate the ability to mobilize regional resources in support of transit agencies in the event of a security threat, and to break from the regular routine and raise the level of security awareness of our passengers.

Operation Transit Shield was first introduced in November 2008 as part of the Regional Domestic Security Task Force Awareness Program. Efforts to support this program have included training nearly 150 Transportation Security Administration and Department of Homeland Security employees from the three regional international airports on Tri-Rail and Miami-Dade Transit system operations and equipment familiarization.

RIDING TRI-RAIL IS A GAME-DAY WIN

Two of the hottest sporting events are coming to South Florida this winter and Tri-Rail is the winning ticket to get fans to and from Land Shark Stadium. On Sunday, January 31, South Florida will host the 2010 Pro Bowl, marking the first time in 30 years that the event is being held on the U.S. Mainland. The next weekend, on Sunday, February 7, the biggest game of all, 2010 Super Bowl XLIV, comes to town. The South Florida Regional

Transportation Authority is adding special Tri-Rail service to provide an economical and efficient means to access both games. Regular weekend fares will be in effect, meaning that Tri-Rail riders

can attend the game for as little as \$2.50 roundtrip if they qualify for a discounted ticket or for just \$5 roundtrip for a regular ticket.

To avoid the anticipated crowds buying train tickets on game days, a special ticket for travel can be purchased in advance on Tri-Rail's website by accessing the Pro Bowl / Super Bowl banner on the Home Page, or from any of Tri-Rail's five Ticket Kiosk locations (West Palm Beach, Pompano Beach, Fort Lauderdale/Hollywood

International Airport Station at Dania Beach, Metrorail Transfer, Miami Airport) during their regular hours of operation beginning December 1. Fans are encouraged to purchase their tickets in advance of game days to avoid long lines at the ticket vending machines.

For both the Pro Bowl and Super Bowl games, special Tri-Rail shuttle buses will meet all trains arriving after 1 p.m. to transport passengers from the Golden Glades Station to Land Shark Stadium, and will be available to



transport passengers back to the station after the conclusion of each game. The plan is to have northbound trains depart the Golden Glades Station one hour and one-and-a-half hours after the final play of each game.

Southbound trains will depart the Golden Glades Station one hour after the final play of each game.

In case fans need to leave early, buses will also be available to take passengers to the station in time to catch northbound Train P674 at 8:48 p.m. or southbound Train P675 at 9:50 p.m.
