TAKE THE TRAIN TO THE PLANE

With the holiday season upon us, many people are making travel arrangements to visit family and friends, or just to get away. Travelers are faced with increased airline fees and costly airport parking costs, but Tri-Rail is the way to go to save money with a stress-free commute to the airport this holiday season.

South Florida residents and visitors can ride Tri-Rail to travel to and from the region's major airports. The commuter rail system provides direct free shuttle bus service from the Hialeah Market/Miami Airport Station* to the Miami International Airport, and back; a free shuttle bus also transports passengers to and from the Fort Lauderdale/Hollywood International Airport Station at Dania Beach; and to access the Palm Beach International Airport,

passengers connect with Palm Tran's Route 44 from the West Palm Beach Station, for a nominal 50-cent transfer with proof of a paid Tri-Rail fare.

As an added convenience, Tri-Rail also offers luggage racks onboard trains and free parking at all stations (Note: 24-hour parking is not available at the Fort Lauderdale/Hollywood International Airport Station at Dania Beach lot or garage.)

Getting onboard is as easy as arriving at a train station, purchasing a pass and getting onboard the train to enjoy your holiday travels.

TOME UN TREN HASTA EL AVIÓN

Con la temporada de fiestas encima, muchas personas están haciendo preparativos de viaje para visitar a familiares y amigos, o solo de paseo. Los viajeros se ven frente a un aumento de las tarifas de las aerolíneas y a elevados costos del estacionamiento de aeropuertos, pero Tri-Rail es la mejor manera de ahorrar dinero con un viaje sin estrés al aeropuerto en esta temporada de fiestas.

Los residentes y visitantes del sur de la Florida pueden utilizar Tri-Rail para viajar desde y hacia los principales aeropuertos de la región. El sistema ferroviario suburbano ofrece gratis un servicio directo de autobús de enlace ida y vuelta entre la Estación Hialeah Market/Miami Airport* y el Aeropuerto Internacional de Miami; un autobús gratuito también transporta pasajeros desde y hacia la Estación Fort Lauderdale/Hollywood International Airport at Dania Beach y, para acceder al Aeropuerto Internacional de

Palm Beach, los pasajeros se conectan con la Ruta 44 de Palm Tran desde la Estación West Palm Beach, con un traslado nominal de 50 centavos y comprobante de un boleto pago de Tri-Rail.

Para mayor comodidad, Tri-Rail también ofrece estantes para equipaje a bordo de los trenes y estacionamiento gratuito en todas las estaciones (Nota: Estacionamiento de 24 horas no está disponible en la Estación Fort Lauderdale/Hollywood International Airport at Dania Beach).

EASY CARD TIP OF THE MONTH

Transferring from Tri-Rail to Miami-Dade Transit (MDT)? Then you must have an EASY Card loaded with cash value to get your transfer discount, unless you already have a Regional Monthly Pass. Passengers transferring from Tri-Rail to MDT and vice versa, can do so seamlessly at no extra charge, with an SFRTA/Tri-Rail or MDT EASY Card loaded with a Regional Monthly Pass.

Tri-Rail passengers using a Tri-Rail paper ticket are required to pay full fare when transferring from Tri-Rail to Metrorail or Metrobus, and the same goes for passengers with an EASY Card that has no cash value and is loaded with a product other than a Regional Monthly Pass.

Passengers with an EASY Card loaded with cash value (minimum of \$2) will pay a transfer discount. Just remember to always tap-on and tap-off to activate your pass.

ATTENTION EDP MEMBERS

Employer Discount Program (EDP) Members no longer receive an EDP ID Card to qualify for their discounts. Instead, an EDP-encoded EASY Card is issued with the member's photo affixed to it. Though the card doesn't expire every year, members must still renew their membership annually to remain active in the program. The expiration month is printed on the card as a reminder for when to renew membership.
