SFRTA Honors Transit Heroes With First-Ever "Distinguished Service Award"

To a rousing standing ovation, the SFRTA presented the first-ever "Distinguished Service Awards" to G4S Custom Protection Officers (CPO) James Errante and Lester Anderson, as well as Conductor Thomas Baker, at the March meeting of the Authority's Governing Board. The award was inspired by the actions of the three transit heroes, who went above and beyond the call of duty to protect and aid Tri-Rail passengers.

In presenting the awards, SFRTA Chair, Commissioner Steven L. Abrams praised the men, saying, "These three heroes are indicative of the quality and caliber of the men and women who serve our Tri-Rail passengers every day. We are honored to have them as part of the SFRTA team."

On February 6, CPO Errante was working at the Golden Glades Station when he met a northbound train in response to a witness' report of a suspicious male with a possible firearm. Upon arrival, he and CPO Lester Anderson removed the suspect from the train. In the ensuing struggle, CPO Errante received 2 gunshot wounds.

During his attempt to assist CPO Errante, CPO Anderson was severely bitten by the suspect, almost severing his thumb. In spite of this, CPO Anderson was able to shoot the suspect when he turned and pointed a gun at him while attempting to flee. CPO Anderson's actions enabled the police to capture the suspect. CPO Anderson has been with G4S for a little more than three years, and was assigned to Tri-Rail because of his law

enforcement background. Both CPOs were severely injured, but their quick actions prevented any harm or loss of life to any passengers.

On February 15, Conductor Thomas Baker was working at the Metrorail Transfer Station when he saw a 65-year-old woman collapse on the east platform. When he reached her, he found she had no pulse and was not breathing. He revived her by performing CPR until EMS arrived. He truly saved her life. Conductor

Baker joined Veolia Transportation in 2010 as an Operations Supervisor and was promoted to Conductor two years later.

pie el primer “Premio al Servicio Destacado” entregado a los oficiales de seguridad de G4S, CPO James Errante y CPO Lester Anderson, así como al Conductor Thomas Baker, en la reunión de marzo del Consejo Directivo de la Autoridad. El premio se inspiró por las acciones de los tres héroes de tránsito, que excedieron los alcances de sus deberes para proteger y ayudar a los pasajeros de Tri-Rail. En la presentación de los premios, el Comisionado Steven

L. Abrams, presidente de la SFRTA elogió a los hombres diciendo: “Estos tres héroes son un indicador de la calidad y el calibre de hombres y mujeres que atienden a nuestros pasajeros de Tri-Rail todos los días. Nos honra tenerlos dentro del equipo de la SFRTA”. El 6 de febrero, CPO Errante estaba trabajando en la estación Golden Glades cuando se subió a un tren con rumbo norte en respuesta a una denuncia de un testigo sobre un sospechoso con una posible

arma de fuego. Al llegar, él y el CPO Lester Anderson retiraron al sospechoso del tren. En el forcejeo resultante, el CPO Errante sufrió 2 heridas de disparo de arma de fuego. Durante su intento de asistir al CPO Errante, el CPO Anderson fue gravemente mordido por el sospechoso, que casi le arrancó un pulgar. A pesar de ello, el CPO Anderson pudo dispararle al sospechoso cuando aquel se dio vuelta y lo apuntó con un arma mientras intentaba escapar. El proceder del CPO Anderson le permitió a la policía capturar al sospechoso. El CPO Anderson trabaja en G4S desde hace poco más de 3 años y fue asignado a Tri-Rail debido a sus antecedentes en el cumplimiento de la ley. Ambos oficiales resultaron gravemente heridos, pero su proceder rápido evitó daños y pérdidas de vidas a pasajeros.

Marlins home games with a 12:40 p.m., 1:10 p.m. or 4:10 p.m. start time are all easily accessible with the existing Tri-Rail train schedule.

How to get there: Ride Tri-Rail to the Metrorail Transfer Station and take the southbound Metrorail to the Culmer Station and board the Marlins Express Shuttle to Marlins Park (regular MDT fares apply). The Marlins Express Shuttle Bus operates 90 minutes before game start times and 60 minutes after the end of the game.

Service to Marlins Park can also be accessed via the Metrorail Civic Center Station by connecting to the free City of Miami Trolley service.

Public Transportation Records Highest Ridership in 57 Years



In 2013, Americans took 10.7 billion trips on public transportation, making it the highest ridership since 1956, according to the American Public Transportation Association (APTA). This was the eighth year in a row that ridership exceeded 10 billion annual trips.

“There is a fundamental shift going on in the way we move about our communities. People in record numbers are demanding more public transit services and communities are benefitting with strong economic growth,” said APTA President and CEO Michael Melaniphy.

Last year was a banner year for ridership on Tri-Rail, as well. More people took Tri-Rail in 2013 than at any other time in the commuter rail system's 25-year history, with a record 4,350, 691 trips. This number even surpasses the passenger count when gas prices were at their highest in 2008. The high ridership from last year is attributable to a recovering South Florida economy and the enhancement of the weekend service to hourly headways.
