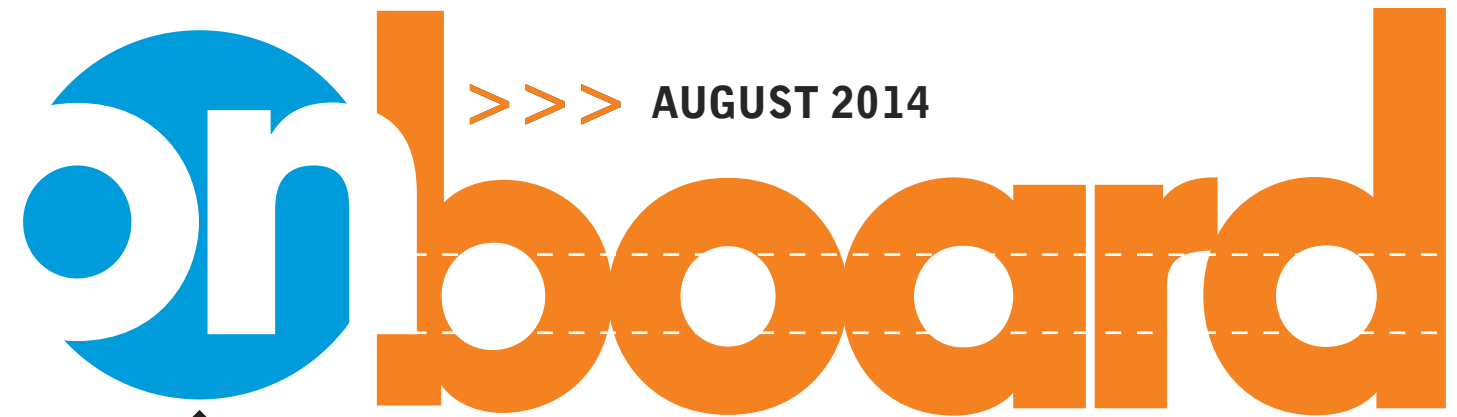

New Discount EASY Card Request and Renewal Page

The SFRTA has launched a new webpage to help facilitate the process for discount-entitled passengers to obtain a Discount SFRTA/Tri-Rail EASY Card. Persons with disabilities, seniors and students can submit their eligibility documents via the web and have their discount-encoded EASY Card mailed directly to them.

Tri-Rail's Service Connected Pass, which grants free Tri-Rail passage for veterans with disabilities, can also be requested on the new web page.

The Discount EASY Card Request and Renewal page provides an alternate option to visiting a Tri-Rail Station Ticket Kiosk during photo station hours of operation, which are the only locations where the discount cards can be obtained. With the launching of this new webpage, discount eligibility documents and user photos that are to be affixed to the cards, can be uploaded online and then reviewed by a virtual agent who processes the request and the \$2 card fee. This means replacement cards can also be requested online.

The new system not only

helps discount fare-users request new or replacement EASY Cards, but it also provides student-discount EASY Card-holders with the ability to renew their eligibility. Since student eligibility is based on information specific to current school terms, students can upload their updated enrollment documents

to ensure that their cards are ready for the beginning of the next school year.

The *Discount EASY Card Request and Renewal* page not only offers flexibility to qualified users from the convenience of their homes, but it also helps relieve current wait times at the ticket kiosks. An active email address is required to access the new page, which is used to communicate status information.

PÁGINA PARA SOLICITUD Y RENOVACIÓN DE LA TARJETA DE DESCUENTO EASY CARD

La SFRTA ha lanzado una nueva página Web para ayudar a facilitar el proceso que implica que los pasajeros con derecho a descuentos reciban una tarjeta de descuento EASY Card de SFRTA/Tri-Rail. Personas con discapacidades, personas de la tercera edad y estudiantes, pueden presentar sus documentos de aptitud por Internet y hacer que se les

envíe la tarjeta EASY Card codificada para descuentos directamente por correo. El pase "Tri-Rail Service Connected Pass", que concede viajes gratuitos en Tri-Rail para veteranos con discapacidades, también se puede solicitar a través de la nueva página Web.

La página para solicitud y renovación de la tarjeta de descuento EASY Card (Discount EASY Card Request and Renewal) brinda una opción alternativa a visitar un quiosco de boletos de estaciones de Tri-Rail durante el horario disponible para tomar fotografías, que son las únicas ubicaciones donde se pueden obtener las tarjetas de descuento. de esta nueva página Web, los documentos de aptitud para descuentos y las fotos de los usuarios que se deben adherir a las tarjetas, se pueden subir en línea y luego ser revisadas por un agente virtual que procesa la solicitud y el cargo de la tarjeta de \$2. Esto significa que las tarjetas de reemplazo también se pueden solicitar por Internet.

El nuevo sistema no solo ayuda a los usuarios de tarifas de descuento a solicitar tarjetas EASY Card nuevas o de reemplazo, sino que también brinda a los estudiantes que utilizan la tarjeta de descuento EASY Card la capacidad de renovar sus requisitos de aptitud. Debido a que los requisitos de aptitud de los estudiantes se basan en información específica de los trimestres escolares actuales, los estudiantes pueden cargar sus documentos de inscripción actualizados a fin de garantizar que sus tarjetas estén listas para comienzos del

próximo año escolar.

New Locomotives Provide More Reliable Commute



Passengers may have noticed that the first two new locomotives are now on the corridor, providing a more reliable commute. They are also more fuel-efficient and run much more quietly than the engines they are replacing. They have considerably more horsepower than the older locomotives, enabling them to easily operate a six-car set. The older locomotives had problems pushing or pulling a four-car set.

The streamlined design of the locomotives includes new federally mandated safety features, a Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) crashworthy all-steel nose and semi-monocoque frame (a minimal structural design which

is reinforced by the unit's exterior skin), equating to an aesthetically pleasing look.

Additional innovative features include a touch-screen locomotive control system to maximize performance in all weather and rail conditions and an ergonomically designed cab interior and desk-style operator station in front of a three-panel window – which provides the broadest possible view of the forward landscape.

Eleven of the twelve new locomotives the SFRTA purchased are in-house and undergoing testing prior to being put into service. The goal is to place a new engine into service approximately every two weeks.

SFRTA Makes Tri-Rail Free for Disabled Veterans

The South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) will allow veterans with disabilities to ride Tri-Rail free of charge starting August 25, 2014. The "Tri-Rail Service Connected Pass" is open to all veterans who present a Service Connected ID card or qualifying documents issued by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, identifying

them as disabled. Veterans with disabilities who wish to avail themselves of this opportunity must obtain an EASY Card with their photo affixed to it. Veterans may get the card at the West Palm Beach, Pompano Beach, Fort Lauderdale/Hollywood International Airport at Dania Beach or Metrorail Transfer stations. Veterans can also

request the pass online at www.tri-rail.com. The SFRTA Governing Board authorized the free pass at a meeting earlier this year, after discussions with the Disabled American Veterans Gold Coast Chapter #133, based in Deerfield Beach. In addressing the Board, Commander Don Carney spoke of how the ability to use the

train without charge would especially be of benefit to veterans with disabilities who ride Tri-Rail to access the VA Hospitals in Palm Beach and Miami-Dade counties. Veterans who are 100 percent disabled and permanent residents of Miami-Dade County can currently ride Miami-Dade Transit for free with the appropriate credentials.
