EDP SPOTLIGHT: SCHOOLS AND TRAINS

For years, students and staff from many of South Florida schools have been taking advantage of Tri-Rail discounts to get them to and from school. Taking the train to campus is a great way to avoid traffic and finish homework.

This month, we spotlight three college campuses that SFRTA staff recently visited. These sites are not only easily accessible for students who can enjoy a 50% discount on the train, but also Employer Discount Program (EDP) participants, providing staff with a 25% discount off Tri-Rail fares.

Palm Beach State College. Palm Beach State College held a multi-day benefits fair for its staff at each of its campuses in

Lake Worth and Boca Raton. The school has been an EDP Employer since 1997. [254 Registered Students / 22 EDP Members]

Nova Southeastern University (NSU). NSU held its 7th annual disabilities expo at its main campus in Davie, featuring services and products geared toward persons with disabilities, including the Tri-Rail "Service Connected Pass", which grants veterans with disabilities free access to the train. NSU has participated in the EDP since 2008. [102 Registered Students / 19 EDP Members]

University of Miami (UM). UM held a week-long benefits fair to provide employees with



a bevy of information, including Tri-Rail's EDP. UM has participated in the program since 1992 and is on record for ordering the largest

quantity of Tri-Rail passes through the agency's Pre-Paid Benefits Program. [551 Registered Students / 112 EDP Members]

SFRTA WINS "BEST OF BEST" IN ITS CLASS

SFRTA turned out to be a big winner during the Florida Public Transportation Association's (FPTA) 40th Annual Conference, held in Naples, FL. The agency brought home two first place and two second place awards from the 2014 FPTA Marketing Awards. One received a special award, recognized as "Best of the Best for Class 1", for receiving the most votes in its class.

This was the first year that the agency was part of Class 1, where it competed with the largest transit agencies in the State of Florida that have an



operating budget over \$36 million.

The list of awards included 1st place (and Best of the Best) for Special Event, "Tri-Rail's 25th Anniversary Luncheon"; 1st place for Print Collateral, "Ride Tri-Rail to Ultra Music Festival"; 2nd place for Sustaining Campaigns, "25 Reasons to Ride Tri-Rail"; and 2nd place Potpourri, "Tri-Rail Commuter Challenge".
