COMMUNITY INPUT SOUGHT FOR FUTURE TRANSIT SYSTEM ON SR 7
FDOT TO HOST PUBLIC MEETING OCT. 26

FORT LAUDERDALE --- The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting concerning the Central Broward East-West Transit Analysis. FDOT is asking for community input to identify station locations and guideway configuration (at-grade or elevated) for a rail transit improvement along State Road 7/US 441 between I-595 and Broward Boulevard.

The meeting will be held Thursday, Oct. 26, at the Jim Ward Community Center, 301 NW 46th Street, in Plantation. Doors open at 6 p.m.

This meeting will include a presentation at 7 p.m. by FDOT on the project's current status and upcoming tasks and activities related to this corridor. Prior to and following the presentation, information about the project and transit will be on display and representatives will be available to discuss the project.

In the near future, other public meetings and workshops will be held to study station locations and guideway configuration for a rail transit improvement along SR 7/US 441 north of Broward Boulevard. Also, a team will be working to identify station locations and guideway configuration along Broward Blvd., from SR 7/US 441 to I-95.
