**South Florida East Coast Corridor Transit Study  
Miami-Dade County Workshops**

**Miami, FL --** The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be holding public workshops for the South Florida East Coast Corridor Transit Study. The study is determining how to best develop rail transit services in a corridor extending from downtown Miami to Jupiter in or adjacent to the Florida East Coast Railway in eastern Miami-Dade, Broward and Palm Beach counties. The public, in a workshop format, will provide feedback on the alternatives recommended to be further analyzed in following phases of the study, including station areas, types of transit vehicles, and route locations. The workshops will be held from 5:30 to 8:00 PM, beginning with public review of project illustrations followed by breakout groups and presentations starting at 6:00 PM.
